(102:8) Then on that Day you shall be asked about the delights (you indulged in, in this world)!



(103:3) Except those who believe (in Islâmic Monotheism) and do righteous good deeds, and recommend one another to the truth [i.e. order one another to perform all kinds of good deeds (Al-Ma'ruf) which Allâh has ordained, and abstain from all kinds of sins and evil deeds (Al-Munkar which Allâh has forbidden], and recommend one another to patience (for the sufferings, harms, and injuries which one may encounter in Allâh's Cause during preaching His religion of Islâmic Monotheism or Jihâd).

(104:1) Woe to every slanderer and backbiter.
(104:2) Who has gathered wealth and counted it.
(104:3) He thinks that his wealth will make him last forever!
(104:4) Nay! Verily, he will be thrown into the crushing Fire.
(104:5) And what will make you know what the crushing Fire is?
(104:6) The fire of Allâh kindled,
(104:7) Which leaps up over the hearts,
(104:8) Verily, it shall be closed upon them,

(105:3) And He sent against them birds, in flocks,
(105:4) Striking them with stones of Sijjîl (baked clay).
(105:5) And He made them like (an empty field of) stalks (of which the corn has been eaten up by cattle).
